

Tour 16**NEWFOUNDLAND****ITINERARY****Day 1****North Sydney - Port Aux Basques**

Meet your **Cabana Tour Director, Driver** and **travelling companions** as we depart from **Halifax** for **North Sydney** with convenient pick up locations along our route. We board our **ferry** sailing time 5 ½ hrs. Visit the lounge where live entertainment is playing, TV/movies, restaurant to overnight in **Port Aux Basques**. **Night [L]**

Day 2**St. John's**

Early departure from **Port Aux Basques** with a relaxing travelling day to **St. John's**. **3 Nights [B]**

Day 3**St. John's**

After breakfast this morning meet in the hotel lobby at **10:30am** for our tour to **Placentia Bay**. We visit **Castle Hill National Historic Park** and **Salmonier Nature Park** where we see most of **Newfoundland's** wildlife in its natural habitat. Continue our journey along **route 90** to **Trespassey, Ferryland, Bay Bulls** back to **St. John's**. **[B-L-A]**

Day 4**St John's**

Early this morning, we have a local **tour guide** to show us highlights of **St. John's** tradition, history and culture. As we continue touring **St. John's**, we visit **Signal Hill National Historic Site, Bell Island** and **Conception Bay**. We finish our round trip through **Cupids Birgus, Bay Roberts** and **Harbour Grace** before we head back to our hotel. **[B-L-A]**

Day 5**Gander**

Today we travel along the **Trans-Canada Hwy** with stops along the way. Our first stop is **Clareville**, a town that lies 192 kilometres from **St. John's** and an equidistant from **Gander** which explains its claim to be "**The Hub of the East Coast**". The highlights today include a scenic drive through **Terra Nova National Park** which encompass approximately 400 square kilometres with a scenic rugged coastline adjoining **Bonavista Bay**. Then we enjoy our drive to **Gander**, known as the crossroads of the world because of its International Airport. After a **short tour**, we **overnight in Gander**. **Night [B-L-A]**

Day 6**Rocky Harbour**

Today we travel along **route 340 & 341** taking us to **Twillingate** where Maritime Archaic Indians lived 3,500 years ago. We continue to our next destination with a **short tour** of **Grand Falls**, the Forest Capital of Canada. We visit the provincial park **logging exhibit** and onto **Rocky Harbour** for overnight. **Night [B-L-A]**

Day 7**Plum Point**

This morning we visit **Gros Morne National Park**, one of two **UNESCO World Heritage Sites** in **Newfoundland & Labrador**. Keep your camera ready as we view outstanding cliffs and deep fjords, that many feel is the most spectacular scenery in North America. We continue along the scenic **Viking Trail to Plum Point** for the next 2 nights. **2 Nights [B]**

Day 8**Plum Point**

We take a day trip to **St. Anthony** where we visit the **Grenfell Historic Properties**. After lunch we tour the second **UNESCO World Heritage Site** in Newfoundland & Labrador, **L'Anse aux Meadows**, site of an eleventh century Viking settlement. The **Newfoundland & Labrador Travel Guide** states "this northern portion of the Great Northern Peninsula has Newfoundland's longest iceberg-watching season". Keep your eyes peeled as we may just see one. We retrace our steps back to **Plum Point**. **[B-A]**

Day 9**Corner Brook**

Relax as we travel towards **Bay of the Islands**, where three islands **Guerney, Tweed** and **Pearl** rise out of the surrounding sea. Later in **Corner Brook** we have a **Guided City Tour**. Our last night in Newfoundland is in **Corner Brook**. **Night [B-A]**

Day 10**Halifax**

Today we depart from **Corner Brook** to **Port Aux Basques** for our ferry crossing (**6 hrs.**) to **North Sydney**. On arrival in **North Sydney** we travel through to **Halifax**. We have a short journey to **Halifax** with stops along the way.
