

**TOUR 20****MAGDALEN ISLANDS****ITINERARY****Day 1****Charlottetown**

Meet your **Cabana Tour Director, Driver** and **travelling companions** this morning as we spend time getting to know one another as we travel through **Nova Scotia, New Brunswick & Prince Edward Island**. Our first stop will be **Gateway Village** for shopping and a lunch break. We then make our way to **Charlottetown** for our first overnight stop. **1 Night**

**Day 2****Iles-de-la-Madeleine**

After an early morning breakfast, we travel through **PEI** to **Souris** where we board a ferry to the **Iles-de-la-Madeleine Islands**. The ferry trip will take 5 hours. Enjoy your cruise, take in the fresh salt air and relax. On arrival we head toward our hotel. **4 Nights [B]**

**Day 3****Cap-aux-Meules**

After breakfast we board the coach for a day of sightseeing. We have a **Tour Guide** for **Cap-aux-Meules Island** today. For the visitors arriving on the **Iles-de-la-Madeleine**, the effect is an immediate and total change in scenery. As far as the eye can see, the islands and the dunes seem to blend, break apart, and then stretch out from view, as though deposited there by the whims of the sea. The archipelago of Iles-de-la-Madeleine is located in the middle of the Gulf of St. Lawrence. The Islands are in the shape of a half moon stretching across a distance of 65kms. **[B]**

**Day 4****Grosse-Ile**

This morning we start by exploring **Pointe-aux-Loups & Grosse-Ile**. There will be time for picture stops, and walking along the gorgeous sand beaches. After an early lunch we start to explore the Island. **[B-A]**

**Day 5****Ile-du-Havre-Aubert**

The **Ile-du-Havre-Aubert** is the biggest of the islands inhabited by french-speaking people. This island has two main villages, **Havre-Aubert & Bassin**. Today we will have time to explore Havre-Aubert, we will visit where the annual Sandcastle Contest is held yearly and you will have some free time on your own to explore the Village. The natural harbor at Havre-Aubert is surrounded by round hills called "Les Demoiselles". The nearby historical site of La Grave is a fascinating highlight in a day full of exploring quiet rolling roads or grassy seaside meadows along sandy beaches. **[B-A]**

**Day 6****Halifax**

We have an early morning ferry to **PEI**. Take the time to have your lunch on board. We will arrive in **Souris** by 2:00pm and continue with a one hour drive to **Charlottetown** where we take a break before completing our trip to Halifax.
